LANDFORD VILLAGE HALL – FIRE SAFETY GUIDANCE AND EMERGENCY PLAN FOR HIRERS

YOU, THE HIRER, are the "*RESPONSIBLE PERSON*" in the event of a fire or emergency within Landford Village Hall during your hire of the hall and you must be in charge and ready to take control of any incident.

PLEASE READ AND BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THESE INSTRUCTIONS

1. BEFORE YOUR EVENT STARTS

- Check that the fire exit lights are working
- Check that all fire exit routes are not blocked by e.g. tables, chairs, boxes, bouncy castles or equipment
- Check that you know where the fire extinguishers are stored
- Check that all electrical equipment and extension leads that have been brought into and/or being used are safe to use
- Check that no balloons or other decorations have been hung so that they could fall down and obstruct a fire exit
- Inform all of your attendees of the fire exit routes and the "Assembly Point" which is located opposite the main entrance in the upper car park

2. DURING YOUR EVENT

- Count the number of attendees
- Ensure that the fire exit routes do not become obstructed
- Brief any to attendees with visual, hearing or mobility issues and/or their assistants regarding their best evacuation route in the event of a fire or emergency
- Ensure that vehicles do not obstruct the fire exits
- Ensure that emergency services vehicles have a clear access route to the hall from Lyndhurst Road
- Ensure that your attendees do not engage in any activity that is likely to cause a fire (e.g. smoking, use of candles or other naked flames)
- Be vigilant regarding any smells of burning or gradual build-up of smoke

3. EMERGENCY PLAN

- In the event of a fire or some other emergency Take Command!
- Give loud and clear instructions and give assistance to attendees with visual, hearing or mobility issues
- Instruct attendees to evacuate the building using the nearest available exit in an orderly manner and gather at the "Assembly Point"
- Start the fire alarm by using the "Break glass points"
- Do not attempt to tackle a fire unless you are trained and confident to do so
- Call the Fire Brigade (DIAL 999) and give this address:

LANDFORD VILLAGE HALL LYNDHURST ROAD LANDFORD SP5 2AE

- Check every room, that is safe to enter, to ensure that everyone has left the premises
- Fire extinguishers should be used to clear a safe passage to the fire exit
- Once outside, at the "Assembly Point" check that everyone is accounted for
- Check that Lyndhurst Road and the area around the hall is clear for the emergency services vehicles
- Ensure a key holder remains available to give the Fire Brigade access if necessary
- Do not return to the building until the Fire Brigade has given instructions to do so

YOUR PRIORITY SHOULD BE TO SAVE LIVES AND NOT THE BUILDING
